The competition is for youth between the ages of 16-19. The purpose of the competition is for youth to know the nutritional value, the economic value, cooking principles, safe handling and versatility of beef and to understand the importance of beef as an agricultural product.

There are three areas evaluated in the competition:

- 1- an oral presentation about beef and or the beef industry (between 5-8 minutes)  
\*If interested in competing on state level this presentation must be given at least 7 times prior. Five of the seven times must be to nonagricultural groups, examples include state fairs, school groups, civic organizations, etc. If we have applicants then State will be held in July.
- 2- questions asked by the judges after the presentation
- 3- an interview to determine one-on-one communication strengths and weaknesses

The winner will earn the right to compete at the State competition, and will receive a \$50. Savings Bond. State winner can then compete at the National competition. National Competition information on following page.
